



Habitat for Humanity of Utah County Home Qualification Requirements 2017

(Updated 7/6/17)

1. Live or work for one year in Utah County.
2. Must be a U.S. Citizen or have permanent resident status.
3. Have the same source of income for at least six months (or show improvement of income)
4. Earn 25%-60% of the Area Median Income. Refer to the chart below and match your total family income with the total number of family members to check your income eligibility.

5. Less than 20% of your income goes to debt. Bankruptcy has to be resolved for at least 2 years.
6. Currently live in substandard housing (water leaks, overcrowding, electrical or heating problems)
7. Show a need, the ability to pay monthly house payment, and be willing to partner with the local Habitat affiliate. Sweat equity hours and down payment are required.
8. You must attend an orientation session to fill out a program application.
